## FAQs:

1. What is World Language class?

A. It is a language class other than English that the students take during their 4 years in high school. Illinois State Board of Education and Adlai E. Stevenson High School (d125) have approved Silicon Andhra ManaBadi standards to offer Telugu as World Language transfer credit class.

2. What is required elective?

A. At least two elective credits must come from any of the following divisions: Applied Arts, Fine Arts and/or World Languages.

3. How many years of outside coursework will be accepted for graduation?

A. Students could potentially earn a maximum of two external semester-credits for this coursework. These would be general electives.

4. In addition to completing Telugu coursework with Silicon Andhra ManaBadi, are the district students required to take an additional World Language coursework in school to fulfill graduation requirements?

A. Private colleges require 4 years or up to eight semester-credits (depending if any work was completed in middle school) -- of language coursework. A student might take Silicon Andhra level 1 course work in grade 7 and complete level 5 in grade 11, there by fulfil 4 years' world language requirement for private college admission. The students are not required to take additional world language course work to graduate from high school.

5. How can a student earn seal of bi-literacy?

A. Complete 2 semester-credits any level coursework with Silicon Andhra ManaBadi. Work with your counselor/ Director of World Languages

6. Where are the classes offered?

7. How to register for the Telugu class to get World Language credit?

A. Consult your school counselor and fill appropriate forms. Register in Silicon Andhra ManaBadi.

8. When is the deadline to register for Telugu class for 2016-17?

A.Check with high school counselor.

9. What about students who finished all levels of ManaBadi course before entering to High school?

A. ManaBadi graduate students entering into  $9^{th}$  grade can enroll in Level 2 and complete the year coursework to get world language credit and also apply for Seal of Bi literacy.
